


The Old English Dramatists

In the delivery, these notes, it appears, were supplemented by a good deal of extemporaneous matter, suggested by the passages from the plays selected for illustrations of the discourse. This extemporaneous matter has not been preserved. The six lectures are devoted to Marlowe, Webster, Chapman, Beaumont and Fletcher, Massinger and Ford. Notwithstanding the somewhat fragmentary nature of its contents, the volume has been very well received. Mr. W. H. Johnson, in The Denison Quarterly (Granville, Ohio), says of the Lectures: They will be searched in vain for any hint of the approaching dissolution of his powers. The same keen insight, the same flow of humor, the same love of the beautiful and good, and the same hatred of the wrong which have marked his whole career, are here in the fullness of their development....
