In view of the large number of descendants of the first Scovil families in Connecticut, and in view of the interest evinced among them in tracing various lineages back to their common source, or to the original center of dispersal in this country, it has been deemed advisable to publish a brief outline of the history of the first few generations, anticipating that this summary will serve as a nucleus...
